Scriptural Tools for Being an Effective Witness

1. I often ask students if they can recite at least ten Bible verses. At first they might think no, but then realize most of us do know at least ten verses we can share with others. The five verses below are just a few that I thought of. Try writing them down the best that you remember them. In addition, try writing down some of the other verses that you know. I'll bet you can do at least ten.
  - a. John 3:16
    - i. ANSWER: "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life." [NIV]
  - b. Genesis 1:1
    - i. ANSWER: "In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth." [NIV]
  - c. Luke 11:2-4
    - i. ANSWER: "And he said unto them, When ye pray, say, Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, as in heaven, so in earth. Give us day by day our daily bread. And forgive us our sins; for we also forgive every one that is indebted to us. And lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil." [KJV]
  - d. Psalm 23
    - i. ANSWER: "The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want. He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the still waters. He restoreth my soul: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake. Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou art with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me. Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies: thou anointest my head with oil; my cup runneth over. Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever." [KJV]
  - e. Psalm 119:11
    - i. ANSWER: "Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee." [KJV]
