| 4         | Used thirty times. Represents “Universality”; looking at all of the world or earth, or when largeness or breadth of view are being emphasized. It is the signature of man and earthly creation. |
| 6         | The number of human activity, as in work for six days. It is also symbolizes that man is one short of perfection, 7; thus it is often used to represent man.                                    |
| 7         | Used 50 times in 22 chapters. It represents perfection, or it represents completion.                                                                                                            |
| 12        | Occurs over 400 times in the Bible and 20 times in Revelation, and represents divine government or the perfect administration of it.                                                            |
| 24        | 2 times 12; fullness of authority and representation, power and judgment or law and grace for example.                                                                                          |
| 42        | 6 times 7; conveys the idea of limitation. Man’s imperfect number and God’s divine number, the working out of man’s opposition to God for example.                                              |
